Stephen Ross (Coal Creek Community Chorus Artistic Director) is a versatile musician and educator who holds a bachelor's degree in music education from the University of Colorado Boulder. He directed the choirs at Skyline High School in Longmont from 2003 through 2015. He currently directs the Balfour Sings! choir at the Balfour Senior Living community in Louisville.

Stephen is a performer and the music director of *Face Vocal Band*, an all-vocal rock band from Boulder. With more than 1,750 performances over 24 years, *Face* performs regularly throughout Colorado and has toured across the United States, Europe, England, Russia, Australia, and around the eastern Caribbean. *Face* has performed in many prestigious venues, including Boettcher Concert Hall (2020, 2022), Red Rocks Amphitheatre (2017, 2019), and Carnegie Hall (2022).

In addition to his music education and performance pursuits, Stephen has adjudicated multiple choir festivals and directed numerous honor choirs, most recently the 2023 Colorado Middle All State Cambiato tenor/bass choir, the 2023 Douglas County School District Men's Choir Festival, the 2023 Adams County Honor Choir, and the 2023 CHSAA Jazz and Show Choir Festival. He is grateful for his incredible wife, three kids, and two dogs, for their love and never-ending support.



Stella Pradeau (Coal Creek Community Chorus Collaborative Pianist) is a private teacher and popular choral collaborator in the Boulder area. In addition to the CCCC, Stella accompanies Cantabile, a Boulder-based auditioned choir, and Balfour Sings! in Louisville. Stella is a graduate of the University of Colorado where she studied with pianists Angela Cheng and Alvin Chow and completed

her master's degree in piano performance. While at CU, Stella was a graduate assistant and winner of the Norris Piano Award.
